Subject is a Senior Telecommunications Technical Officer Grade 1 with the Monaro Section, Engineering Department, Canberra. It is expected that when the Telecom Tower, Black Mountain is commissioned, he will be based there as a shift STTO responsible for television and RT maintenance. The Tower will carry a Department of Defence Key Point Category 2 rating. Currently he is in charge of the Australian Breadcasting Commission radio transmitters (2CY/2CN), a Category 3 Key Point and the maintenance of the ABC television transmitters (ABC3).

- 2. On 24.6.75 he was submitted for name check to your HQs on Special Duties List No.35/1975(NSW), as Serial No.80. The list was returned on 4.9.75 NAK with exception of Serial 80, ROY, William Francis. On 10.10.75, the subject of Mr. ROY was discussed between your HQs and mine. Your HQs advised to the effect that Mr. ROY was scored out owing to an internal record checking procedure which could refer to an adverse trace, the person's name coming up in the context of vague and/or unsubstantiated information, or received from subsequently proved unreliable or biased sources etc.. Your HQs spokesman went on to say that there was no security interest in Mr. ROY. As a result of this assessment, we then deleted him lfrom our list of Persons of Interest.
- 3. On 17 November, 1976, I attended a conference of Senior Officers in Sydney at which industrial relations and security problems relating to the Tower were discussed. After the conference adjourned, I was asked by the Manager, Buildings Branch, Mr. J.F. McCarthy and the Supervising Engineer, Monaro Section (Canberra) Mr. Don Ferguson to stay behind to discuss a confidential matter. The subject of the discussion was William Francis ROY. Mr. McCarthy told me that the State Manager Mr. W.T. Schmidt had informed him that he was concerned that this man was going to be employed in the Tower, as he was deeply involved with the environmentalist movement in Canberra which opposed the Tower's construction. You are no doubt aware of the controversy which has surrounded the Tower in thepast and of the minor acts of sabotage which occurred during early construction stage. Mr. Ferguson told me that ROY was still hostile towards the Tower and that his loyalty (to the Commission) was open to serious question. I was asked for advice as to what could be done about him. Naturally I had to say that he was not adversely recorded, but that administrative action might be taken to employ him elsewhere in Canberra. It appears that this is not possible because of his radio/ TV specialty.
- 4. Subsequently ROY, because of hist-possible involvement in Key Point security, was nominated for a clearance. He was cleared to SECRET level on list NATC 129/76 dated 7.12.76. The Police Check was clear. A copy of the list file is attached.
- 5. I visited Black Mountain Tower on 16.2.77. On 14.2.77 I saw th our Assistant Manager (Industrial Services) Mr. F.W. Jones who is handling the potential industrial relations xix issues relating to the Tower. During

the course of conversation, Mr. Jones told me that one William Francis ROY was sponsoring a scheme to promote a series of industrial issues intended to disrupt Tower operations over a period of time. As far as is known ROY has no official status with the Australian Telecommunications Employees Association (ATEA). However, the radio group in Canberra have set up what is called the Radio Reorganization Committee and it is thought ROY may be using this non-union body as a vehicle to promotem his anti-Tower cause.

6. I have passed all this on to My HQs who have requested that I discuss the subject with your representative with a view to reassessing the original "trace", however doubtful it might appear to have been at the time of the previous assessment.

- special observations on home of Richard OADES, Secretary of Fairfield Branch of Communist Party of Australia reported seeing motor vehicle UX.293 (Skoda sedan) at the premises on four occasions (dates and times given) in 1954 and 1955.
- (f) At approximately 8.50 p.m. on 11.9.55, subject's car UX.293 was observed parked outside the home of Robin Allenby GOILAN, 5 Banksia St., O'Connar, Canberra. (Regional Director, A.C.T.'s memorandum 1933 of 12.9.55.)
- 2. supplies the additional item that in 1952 subject was one of the signatories to a protest petition against the ban on the use of Hollywood Park for the Youth Carnival for Peace and Friendship.

Discussion:

Considering items 1(a), 1(b) and 2, it is reasonable to conclude that subject was using his car when it was noted at the places of security interest. The visits of the car to OADES' home suggests that subject (whose home is in the adjoining suburb) is a member of the C.P. of A. Branch of which OADES is Secretary.
