

HAWKES VISIT TO MOSCOW

PLEASE REPEAT AS CONSIDERED APPROPRIATE

YOUR 200

FOLOWING REPORT ON HIS MISSION WAS GIVEN TO US BY HAWKE ON 26 JULY.

2. AS SHELEPIN, SOVIET TRADE UNION CHIEF, WAS NOT IN MOSCOW, HAWKE WAS TAKEN BY AIR TO MEET HIM AT A RESORT ON THE BALTIC.

HE HAD A 5-HOUR SESSION WITH SHELEPIN ALONE WITH AN INTERPRETER.

SHELEPIN MADE COPIOUS NOTES OF WHAT HAWKE HAD TO SAY. TOPICS DISCUSSED WERE:-

- (A) INTERNATIONAL TRADE UNION AFFAIRS.
 - (B) MIDDLE EAST SITUATION AND ARAB-ISRAEL RELATIONS.
 - (C) POSITION OF SOVIET JEWRY,
 - (D) INVITATION TO SHELEPIN FROM SECRETARY-GENERAL OF HISTADRUT, BEN AHARON TO VISIT ISRAEL.
- (A) SHELEPIN SPOKE OF DISCUSSIONS SOVIET OFFICIALS HAD HAD WITH WESTERN TRADE UNION OFFICIALS IN HELSINKI AND OF THE IMPORTANCE HE ATTACHED TO DEVELOPING CONTACTS BETWEEN SOVIET AND WESTERN TRADE UNIONISTS.
- (B) ON THE MIDDLE EAST SITUATION HAWKE SPOKE FOR AN HOUR OUTLINING THE ISRAELI POSITION.

 HE SPOKE OF ISRAEL'S DESIRE FOR A SETTLEMENT EMPHASIS-ING THAT ISRAELIS INTEREST WAS ESSENTIALLY IN SAFE GUARDING THEIR SECURITY AND NOT IN THE ACQUISITION OF TERRITORY.

HE OUTLINED THE LIMITED EXTENT OF ISRAEL'S TERRITORIAL DEMANDS (EG, GOLAN HEIGHTS, AND SHARM EL SHEIKH) AND THEIR READINESS TO NEGOTIATE.

HAWKE DREW A PARALLEL WITH THE SOVIET'S OWN PREOCCUPAT-

ION WITH THE SECURITY OF ITS BORDERS IN EUROPE.

HE SAID THAT ISRAEL FULLY APPRECIATED RUSSIA'S

POST-WAR ATTITUDE TOWARDS GERMANY.

IN REPLY SHELEPIN SAID SOVIET INTEREST IN MIDDLE EAST WAS BASED SOLELY ON SECURITY CONSIDERATIONS.

THEY HAD NO ECONOMIC INTEREST THERE: RUSSIA HAD ALL

THE OIL AND COTTON IT NEEDED.

THE SOVIET UNION HAD AS MUCH RIGHT TO BE IN THE MEDITER-ANEAN AS THE US 6TH FLEET WITH ITS POLARIS MISILES AIMED AT THE SOVIET UNION.

SHELEPIN EMPHASISED THAT RUSSIA DID NOT WISH TO SEE THE LIQUIDATION OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND HAD MADE THIS

CLEAR TO ITS ARAB FRIENDS.

HOWEVER, HE BELIEVED ISRAEL SHOULD WITHDRAW FROM ALL OCCUPIED TERRITORIES AND ITS SECURITY WOULD BE PROVIDED FOR

BY THE UNITED NATIONS WITH GREAT POWER GUARANTEES.

HAWKE SAID IT SEEMED TO HIM THAT THE PRESENT SITUATION CONFRONTED THE SOVIET UNION WITH SOMETHING OF A DILEMMA: SOME PEOPLE IN THE ARAB WORLD DID NOT SHARE THE SOVIET VIEW OF THE RIGHT OF ISRAEL TO EXIST AND COULD LAUNCH WAR IN WHICH, IF IT WERE TO BE SUCCESSFULLE WAGED, THEY WOULD SEEK TO INVOLVE SOVIET PERSONNEL.

THIS WOULD NOT NOT ONLY INVOLVE A SOVIET WAR AGAINST ISRAEL BUT ALSO A POSSIBLE CONFLICT WITH THE UNITED STATES

WHICH HE KNEW THE SOVIETS WISHED TO AVOID.

HAWKE POINTED TO THE IMPENDING US-CHINA DETENTE WHICH WAS THE CURRENT FOCUS OF INTERNATIONAL ATTENTION AND SAID THAT WORLD OPINION WOULD LOOK TO THE SOVIET UNION FOR AN APPROPRIATE RESPONSE IN THE NEW INTERNATIONAL SPIRIT OF DETENTE.

THE PLACE TO DO THIS WAS IN THE MIDDLE EAST WHERE THE

POLITICAL CONFRONTATION WAS MOST DANGEROUS.

RUSSIA SHOULD TAKE SOME INITIATIVES TO PROMOTE PEACE NEGOTIATIONS.

IT COULD ONLY PLAY AN APPROPRIATE ROLE IF IT TALKED WITH

BOTH PARTIES TO THE DISPUTE.

SHELEPIN GAVE THE IMPRESSION THAT HE PERSONALLY WOULD LIKE TO SEE SOME SHIFT IN SOVIET POLICY, IN HAWKE'S WORDS "TO GET IT OFF THE HOOK".

HE WAS PARTICULARLY INTERESTED IN THE IMPLICATIONS OF

(C) ON THE SITUATION OF SOVIET JEWRY, HAWKE SAID THAT BY THEIR ANTI-JEWISH POLICIES THE SOVIET AUTHORITIES WERE CREATING INTERNAL PROBLEMS FOR THEMSELVES AND WERE MAKING A BAD IMPRESSION INTERNATIONALLY.

SHELEPIN FREELY ACKNOWLEDGED THAT A PROBLEM EXISTED. HE SAID THE JEWS CONSTITUTED ON TWO AND HALF PER CENT OF THE TOTAL POPULATION BUT FIFTEEN PER CENT OF SOVIET SCIENT-ISTS WERE JEWISH.

THEY OCCUPIED ESSENTIAL POSITIONS IN THE ESTABLISHMENT

AND HAD ACCESS TO STATE SECRETS.

HOW COULD THEY BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE?

HAWKE AGREED THAT THIS WAS A PROBLEM BUT ARGUED THAT PEOPLE IN IMPORTANT POSITIONS HAD SUFFICIENT STAKE IN

THE SOVIET ESTABLISHMENT NOT TO WANT TO LEAVE.

BUT BY THEIR ANTI-JEWISH POLICIES THE AUTHORITIES WERE CREATING DISCONTENT AMONGST ALL JEWS IN THE SOVIET UNION AND CONTRIBUTING TO THE PRESSURE TO LEAVE. SHELEPHIN SAID THEY ALSO HAD TO CONSIDER THE EFFECT ON OTHER NATIONAL MINORITY GROUPS IF THEY LET THE JEWS EMIGRATE FREELY.

(D) IN PRESENTING BEN AHARON'S INVITATION TO SHELEPIN TO VISIT ISRAEL HAWKE DREW ON WHAT SHELEPIN HAD SAID EARLIER ABOUT HIS DESIRE FOR MORE EXCHANGES BETWEEN SOVIET AND WESTERN TRADE UNIONISTS.

HOWEVER, SHELEPIN SAID A VISIT TO ISRAEL WOULD BE VERY DIFFICULT FOR HIM IN THE LIGHT OF SOVIET RELATIONS WITH

THE ARAB WORLD.

3. HAWKE FELT THAT THE VIEWS HE HAD PRESENTED TO SHELEPIN HAD BEEN CAREFULLY REGISTERED AND HE HAD THE IMPRESSION THEY WOULD IN DUE COURSE BEAR FRUIT. SHELEPIN PROMISED TO KEEP HIM INFORMED OF DEVELOPMENTS THROUGH THE SOVIET AMBASSADOR IN CANBERRA.

SHELEPIN INSISTED THAT THEIR CONVERSATION SHOULD BE

KEPT STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL.

HAWKE HAS REPORTED THE ABOVE TO EBAN BUT IS NOT REVEALING ANYTHING OF HIS MOSCOW DISCUSSION TO THE PRESS.
