# INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETION OF FORM R.A.1.

To be read carefully by alien before completion.

With the exception of those aliens exempted from registration, this form is to be completed by every alien resident in Australia who is 16 years of age or over on the 1st January, 1948. In the case of a child the form will be completed when the child reaches the age of 16 years.

The form must be signed before and witnessed by one of the following persons:—

When completed, signed and witnessed, the form together with previous Certificate of Registration, if any, shall be lodged at the Department of Immigration if the alien is residing in a Capital City, or with the nearest Post Office at which money order facilities are available, if the alien is residing outside a Capital City.

The applicant shall provide two identical photographs of himself with this form of application. The photographs shall be approximately 2½ inches by 2 inches in size, of head and shoulders only, taken full face, without hat and with plain background.

The alien shall subsequently be advised by letter to call at the Post Office or Department of Immigration where the application was lodged to be issued with his new certificate of registration.

If married, details of husband or wife as the case may be and of children under the age of 16 years:—

**WARNING**

Sections 13, 14 and 20 of the Aliens Act 1947 read as follow:—

**Sec. 13.** An officer may require any person whom he believes to be an alien to furnish information as to his name, the date and place of his birth, his nationality, residence and occupation and to produce any document or other evidence in his possession or control relating to those matters, and a person who is so required shall not refuse or fail to supply that information or to produce the document or other evidence or knowingly give false or misleading information.

**Sec. 14.** An alien shall not make any false statement in any application or other document under this Act or the regulations.

**Sec. 20.** Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of this Act shall be guilty of an offence.  
**Penalty:** Fifty pounds or imprisonment for three months.
