**MR. FORDE MAY
TAKE EXTENDED
TERM**

SYDNEY, Sunday.

The Australian High Commissioner in Ottawa, Mr. F. Forde, had been offered an extension of nine months in his appointment, the Minister for External Affairs, Mr. Casey, said in Sydney tonight.

The Minister said that Mr. Forde's five-year-term would normally end this month, but if accepted the extension offer, he would be there until July.

Mr. Casey said he had no reason to doubt that Mr. Forde would accept the extension. The Minister also said the Australian Government would make an early decision regarding appointment of an Australian High Commissioner in Ceylon.
