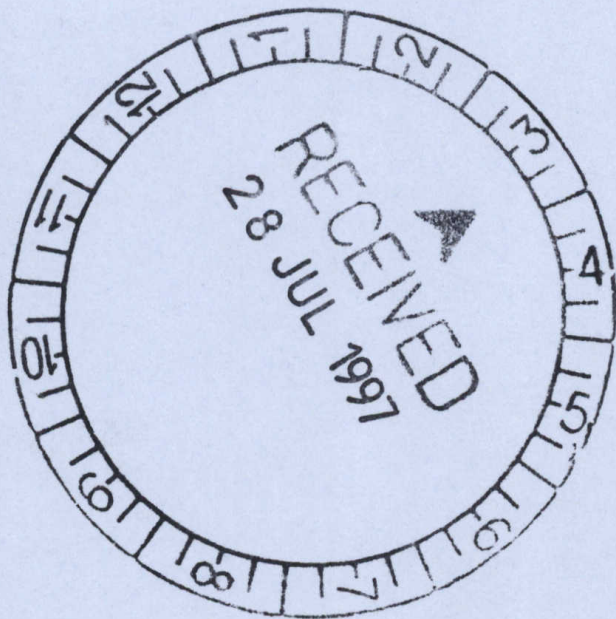

1. I refer to your inquiry received at this office on 31 July 1997 regarding medal entitlements. I apologise for the delay in replying to your enquiry, which has been due to this office being inundated with medal requests. Thank you for being patient.
2. Following from recent amendments made to the regulations governing a number of service awards, I am pleased to advise that you are now eligible for the award of the 1939/45 Star, which is now also awarded for operational service in a designated Pacific theatre of operations at any time during the six months immediately prior to and including 2 September 1945. This medal will be forwarded to you on receipt from our engraver.
3. I am pleased to advise that you are also eligible for the award of the Australian Service Medal 1945-1975 with Clasp SW PACIFIC which is awarded for 30 days service in the Netherlands Indies, Portuguese Timor, Sarawak, Brunei, British Borneo, Philippine Islands, Solomon Islands, Nauru and Ocean Islands, Burma, Malaya and Singapore, and including all islands and waters forming part of those territories between 3 September 1945 and 24 November 1946; and for participation in Royal Australian Air Force military activities on Morotai Island between 3 September 1945 and 10 July 1948.
4. This office will now recommend to the Governor General that the award be made. Upon approval, this office will arrange for the medal to be engraved and dispatched to you. Please note that the issue of the Australian Service Medal 1945/75 with Clasp SW PACIFIC will take approximately 8-10 weeks.
5. By way of your service with the Australian Army you qualified for the following awards, which now constitutes your full entitlement:
  - a. 1939/45 Star
  - b. Pacific Star
  - c. War Medal 1939/45
  - d. Australia Service Medal 1939/45
  - e. Australian Service Medal 1945/75 with Clasp SW PACIFIC
  - f. Returned from Active Service Badge
