With reference to telex Kersley from Castle dated 15th February, 1967, attached for your information is copy of M.304 report together with copy of interviewing officer's report in relation to this family.

2. Although all the children were not seen by the Interviewing officer, it is apparent from discussions with Immigration Inspector that all these children are predominantly non-European in appearance and that apart from Mr. Gouges none of the family speak any English.
3. Mrs. Gouges could be a definite integration problem because of her lack of education, low intellect and inability to understand English. The comments of Mrs. P. d'Espaignet (Mr. Gouges' sister) that she did not anticipate this family would be permitted entry because of their dark colour is significant. Mrs. d'Espaignet was the person who assisted our officers at the Airport in completing passenger cards by acting as an interpreter.
4. It is considered that if this family had been submitted to a Selection Interview before entry they would not have been authorized to enter.
5. In view of the numbers of persons now entering from Mauritius (approximately 200 arrived per "Australis" at Fremantle on 27th February, 1967) perhaps consideration could be given to an Officer calling at Mauritius at specified periods to interview prospective migrants and thus obviate entry of persons within this category.

Letters of children stated were to travel with father. He is in Australia (arrived 19/8/66).

This group is the worst group I have seen from Mauritius, as they are predom. negroid in appearance & deepish brown in colour. They are clean & well dressed, but speak only French. We had great difficulty with language when arranging completion of passage cards (not completed on arrival) & had to call in an interpreter. I feel they may be an integration problem.

Action Taken:

I saw the father waiting at the airport. He is a small man, slightly better in appearance than the rest of the family. As he did not have his passport with him, I was unable to confirm what type of Entry Permit he held so issued wife & children T.E.P. 30 days & requested Mr Gouges to present his passport & Act for his family to our office.

I interviewed Mr. and Mrs. Gouges in the office this morning and agree that they are both very much predominantly N/E in appearance - Mrs. much more so than Mr.

2. The children were not with them and from their comments when I expressed surprise that they were not I assumed they were at home so did not press the matter further. I now understand they were in the car in front of the office.

3. Mrs. Gouges does not speak a word of English. She appears to be of low intellect, lacks education and culture but was quite reasonably well clad. She intends studying English at night school.

4. Mr. Gouges understands and speaks English fairly well although they speak only French in the home. He seems quite intelligent and reasonably well educated. Is employed as a concrete worker (he says as a foreman) by Swan J. Concrete Constructions Pty. Ltd., of Kelmscott. This was his trade in Mauritius also.

5. They are renting an old house at 5 Loftus Street, Leederville at present but will be moving to a better house at Mount Lawley within the next fortnight.

6. Apparently none of the children speak English at all with the exception of the eldest who, they say, can speak a little. They will, however, soon overcome this drawback once they start school and will no doubt integrate quite well, as will their father. Mrs. Gouges will experience difficulty in this respect.

7. Mr. Gouges' sister, Mrs. P. d'Espaignet of 14 Leyland Road, St. James Park, accompanied them to the office. She is much lighter skinned than her brother, is well educated (has her Leaving), and very intelligent with a good personality. Her husband is a technician with the P.M.G. Department. They have been here for 4 years and their 2 children are Australian born. Her brother is the darkest of her family.

8. Another brother, Yves Gouges, arrived here on 10.4.1966. He is a meter reader with the S.E.C., at Northam. He is single and, according to Mrs. d'Espaignet, is as fair as she is.

9. Mrs. d'Espaignet expressed disappointment that an older sister and her family had just been rejected for admission. She said they were all fair skinned and well educated and well off financially. Husband an Accountant, sister private secretary, elder children Leaving Standard, etc. She will make reps. to C.O. Stated she would not have been surprised, in fact quite expected, that the Gouges family now here would have been rejected because of their dark colour but this does not apply to her sister.

10. Type "D" permit issued to Mrs. Gouges and children.

I called at 5 Loftus Street, Leederville today and saw three of the Gouges children - the older ones being at school.

The house is old, shockingly dilapidated and dirty and is being shared with another Mauritian family. Both these families intend moving to a house in Wasley Street, North Perth next week.

The two young boys I saw are both very much N/E in appearance., and in this respect are very like their mother. The little girl is not so dark or negroid in appearance and would no doubt be acceptable under our mixed race policy. I imagine the 3 older children would be very similar in appearance to the three young ones. They do not appear to understand English.

Mr. Gouges and his family would now be regarded as being of mixed descent and having been granted resident status, despite the fact that their Letters of Authority did not carry the endorsement, "Special Condition H".

MIGRANTS FROM MAURITIUS

REPORT BY PERTH OFFICE

Attached is a report from the Perth Office concerning one family and three persons who, on arrival at Perth Airport were considered to be below "previous standards, principally on racial appearance".

2. Mr. Raymond Sullivan and some of his children were considered to be borderline integration prospects mainly because of their noticeable non-European appearance. They were approved in this Section on 12.11.1965.

3. Mr. Jean Jacques Gouges was reported to be noticeably non-European. His family apparently plans to follow him. They were approved by O.B.O. on 3.5.1966.

4. Mr. Pierre Christian Grenouille was reported as "fairly dark in appearance and possibly the most noticeable of Mauritians dealt with recently". He was approved by O.B.O. on 29.10.1965.

5. Mr. Jean Richmond Rose who was considered a borderline case in regard to appearance was approved by O.B.O. on 3.5.1966.

6. The Perth report states that the photographs have not, in these cases, given a good indication of racial appearance. Selecting applicants for entry for residence by photograph and application form, but without the benefit of an interviewing office report can be expected to give, at times, unsatisfactory results. Now that the Mixed-Race sub-section is handling, initially, all Mauritian applicants, other than those considered by Registering to be non-European, more consistent results should be achieved.

Migrants from Mauritius :
Reference: Your 65/46618 of 17.6.66.

As requested, we have been maintaining a watch on Mauritians arriving here and until recently have had little to report, as the general standard has appeared good.

2. Over the last few weeks, however, there have been a few cases which have fallen below previous standards, principally on racial appearance. Although these persons have been easily identified from photographs on the Letters of Authority, we consider the photographs have not given a good indication of the racial appearance.

3. Cases under notice have been -

- (a) Mr. Raymond Sullivan, his wife Lise and children Samuel M., Phillippe D., Jean L., Desire P., Anne H. and Louise E., the grantees of Letter of Authority issued at your office on 13th January 1966, reference 65/30007. These persons arrived on Qantas Flight QF622 on 19th July 1966 and whilst Condition "H" cases, were considered borderline integration prospects. Whilst of mixed race, Mr. Sullivan and some of the children had noticeable non-European appearance, although European in mode of dress and general outlook. Mrs. Sullivan spoke reasonable English, but the husband's knowledge appeared rather limited, although this will probably not limit him in his trade as a welder any more than it would an alien. These persons were proceeding to 49 William Street, Dandenong, Victoria. No restrictive action was taken.
- (b) Mr. Jean Jacques GOUGES, the grantee of Letter of Authority No. 709, Reference 66/12989. Mr. Gouges arrived at Perth Airport per Flight SA-242 on 20th August 1966 and was reported by the examining officer as being of mixed race, but noticeably non-European. Mr. Gouges was proceeding to 111 Leyland Street, St. James Park, W.A.
- (c) Mr. Pierre Christian GRENOUILLE, the grantee of Letter of Authority issued on 29th October 1965, Reference 65/16587. He arrived at Perth Airport per Flight QF622 on 23rd August 1966, destined for 205 Dandenong Road, Windsor, Victoria. Mr. Grenouille is fairly dark in appearance, possibly the most noticeable of Mauritians dealt with recently. Apart from this, his prospects of integration would be reasonable, as he gives his occupation as nursing and was formerly at the Princess Margaret Orthopaedic Centre, Mauritius.

(d) Mr. Jean Richmond ROSE, the grantee of Letter of Authority issued 3.5.66, reference 66/22935, proceeding to 4 Robertson Avenue, St. Kilda, Victoria. He arrived per Qantas Flight QF622 on 23rd August 1966 and the examining officer considered him a borderline case as regards appearance, although he appeared to meet other integration requirements.

4. No restrictive action was taken with these people.
