INSTRUCTIONS IN RESPECT OF THE ISSUE OF MOTHER'S AND WIDOW'S BADGE.

The badge will be issued to the mother and/or widow of members of the Australian Mercantile Marine who have been killed, or have died from wounds or other causes whilst on duty. *Or as a result of service in the Mercantile Marine*

2. Stars will be attached to the badges as under:-

Widow of a deceased member	1 star
Mother of one deceased member	1 star
" " two " members	2 stars
" " three " "	3 stars
" " four " "	4 stars
" " five " "	5 stars

3. A widow of a deceased member who is also a mother of a deceased member or members will receive one badge only with a star on account of each deceased son or daughter, as well as a star on account of the deceased husband.

4. If a mother of a deceased member has already received a badge in respect of a son who died on active service, she will not be entitled to a second badge in respect of a son who died whilst serving in the Merchant Service. She will, however, be entitled to a star on his account.
