RAAF.163/110/22(29A) Dear Madam, As it is some time now since you have heard from this Department with regard to your husband, Sergeant Colin Fallen, who is reported missing but believed to have lost his life in India, I am writing to assure you that enquiries are constantly being made on your behalf. In regard to members missing an certain other theatres of war, the fact that no information concerning them is received after the lapse of a period of time gives ground for presuming that the member may have lost his life. It is felt that if a member missing in these theatres of war were safe, he would find some means of communicating with his Unit or his next of kin, or that news of him would he forthcoming through the International Red Gross Committee, Geneva. However, it has not been possible to make such a deduction in regard to members missing in India and Burma or in operations against the Japanese Fleet, as much difficulty has been experienced in obtaining information concerning prisoners of war held by the Japanese. Therefore, the Air Ministry, London, has decided that the presumption of death of members attached to the Royal Air Force who have become missing in these areas should be held in abeyance and action deferred until such time as complete lists of prisoners held by the Japanese are released through the International Red Cross Committee, Geneva. Bay I again express the sincere sympathy of this Department with you in your anxiety, and assure you that should further news of your husband be received, or the question of presuming death be considered you will be informed immediately. I first noticed a long dense stream of white smoke issue from the aircraft at 13,000 feet, which then broke away from the formation in a steady dive into the sea. Following it down, I saw an object leave at 3,000 feet, then the aircraft flicked over on its back and dived straight down into the sea. Object indistinct.

There were two definite splashes, and although myself and Black 2 circled the position for approximately ten minutes all I saw was a large patch of oil and one of the auxiliary petrol tanks. At 2,000 feet I tried to contact 'KAYAK' but as there was no reply I called Black 2, who indicated he also was not receiving, but afterwards I found cut that he was indicating that his own R/T was unserviceable. As I had concluded my R/T was out of order, I pinpointed the position of the crash, and returned to base and reported all information possible.
