PARSTRUCTION OF DEATH OF CREW OF HUDSON A16-132

The following members the crew of Hudson A16-132 of 13 Squadron were reported by No. 2 Base Personnel Staff Office, to be missing from an operational flight on 17th June, 1942:-

Pilot Officer Brian Ernest LONG (403888) Filot Officer Gordon Robert CHAMFORD (403802) Filot Officer Colin Vivian CAMTOR (441861) 40137 Bergeant McGUIRE, Maurice 411908 Bergeant HAYMARD, Laurence Rex

- 2. It is desired to presume the deaths of the abovenamed members.
- 3. Thirteen Squadron has furnished a memorandum setting out the circumstances under which the aircraft was lost, (enclosure 3A).
- 4. A16-132 took off from Hughes, at 0115/2 hours on 17th June, 1942, on a diverging track search. Datum was Darwin. Two other aircraft were engaged on this search with tracks one on the North and one on the South of the track flown by A16-132, para 2 of enclosure 34
- 5. At 0715/A., A16-132 signalled that the starboard engine had failed and the aircraft was coming in on one motor, (Para, 4 of ene.3A).
- 6. The position of the aircraft at the time of sending the 8.0.8 was estimated to be 120 003 1280 40 E. (para 5 of enclosure 3A).
- 7. at 0804/2 E.T.A. was received at Derwin and necessary arrangements were made for the aircraft to land (para 4 enclosure 34., and Enclosure 24.)
- 8. The aircraft did not land at Derwin nor did it return to its
- 9. Requests were continually made to R.D.F. through 4. C.H. for plots, which eventually proved to be plots of other aircraft (para 5 enclosure 3.2).
- 10. Searches were carried out for the missing aircraft from 17th June, 1942, to 21st June, 1942, inclusive, but these searches were unsuccessful, 'para, 7 of enclosure 3A).
- 11. Nothing has been seen or heard of A16-132 or its crew since 17th June, 1942.
- 12. Communications have been sent to the next of kin of the missing members enquiring whether they have received any news indicating the possibility of the members being alive. These enquiries have, however, produced negative results.
- 13. It is not considered possible that any of the abovenamed members will be found alive.
