Dear Madam,

I refer to your letter dated 22nd November, 1946, concerning your late son, Pilot Officer Beresford Stanley Reilly,

I regret to inform you that no further information regarding the sad loss of your son has become known, subsequent to that conveyed to you in previous correspondence.

As advised in my letter to you dated the 3rd April, 1944, your son was the wireless airgumer in a Baltimore aircraft detailed to take part in a low level bombing attack on the central section of Grete on the 23rd July, 1945. An S.O.S. message was received from the aircraft, and its position was fixed on the south coast of Grete.

In view of this evidence and the long lapse of time in which no trace of your son or his aircraft has been found, it is the reluctant opinion of this Department that his ultimate fate may never be known.

The matters relating to badges and war gratuity will be the subjects of separate communications.

Permit me to assure you of the continued sympathy of my Department in your great loss.





Dear Sir, I note with regret that you were not fully informed following the initial notification to you that your late son had been posted missing, all communications between such time and the official presumption of death having been directed to your late son's widow only. Your late son was the wireless airgumer in a Baltimore aircraft, which took off from its base in the Middle East to take part in a low level bombing attack on the central section of Crete on the 23rd July, 1943. An S.O.S. message was received from the aircraft, and its position at that time was fixed on the south coast of Crafe, west of Iarapatra. I regret to state that nothing was heard of or seen of the aircraft after that message. All subsequent effort to obtain any information as to the fate of your son was unavailing, and the Air Hinistry subsequently made an official presumption of his death. I desire to advise that your late son was granted a commission with the rank of Pilot Officer with retrospective effect from the 20th June, 1943.
