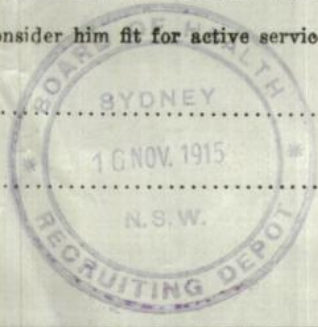

I remained with the Battalion details, Steenvarde and subsequently moved back to Cashe. I did not see Private Scullin, beyond seeing his name since in a casualty list. I have no knowledge of what happened to him or what became to him. There was another Private Ross (2476) in the Battalion, but I do not know what company and I think he has been killed.

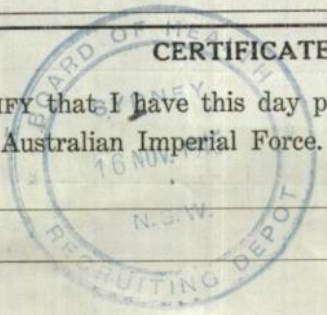
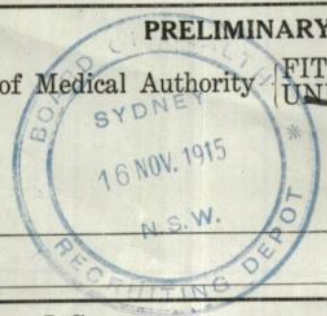
