

NOTES AND INSTRUCTIONS.

6. APPLICATIONS FOR CASHING OF BONDS IN NECESSITOUS CASES.—A Board will be appointed in each Capital city of the Commonwealth to consider applications for the cashing of Bonds in necessitous cases. When these Boards are appointed, applications for the cashing of Bonds in necessitous cases should be forwarded to the Board in the State in which the applicant resides.

7. APPLICANTS TO FURNISH FULL INFORMATION.—All applicants should complete as far as possible the particulars of overseas service (if any), and particulars of service in Australia (see pages 2 and 3 of this Ferm), to assist the Department in identification. Failure to furnish full information will result in payment being delayed.

8. MEMBERS WITH NO OVERSEAS SERVICE,—Where an application is made in respect of a member with "No Overseas Service," the applicant must fill in two copies of this Form, otherwise payment will be withheld.

9. SIGNATURES REQUIRED .- Applicants should carefully note that six signatures are required to complete this Form.

10. IMPERIAL RESERVISTS.—If a claim is made in respect of an Imperial Reservist, this Form should be suitably amended to furnish the fullest details possible regarding the deceased soldier. The amount of the gratuity received from the Imperial Government should also be stated in the space provided for "Information" on this page.

11. BONDS WILL BE ISSUED TO ORIGINAL APPLICANTS ONLY .- Bonds will be issued to the original applicants only.

12. APPLICATIONS, when completed, should be forwarded to the District Finance Officer of the State in which the deceased soldier enlisted. Envelopes should be indorsed "War Gratuity."

13. CHANGE OF ADDRESS.—If you change your address after forwarding this application, notify your new address to the District Finance Officer. Omission to notify change of address will delay payment.

WAR LEAVE PAYMENT—DECEASED SOLDIERS.

1. A War Leave Payment on the undermentioned scale and subject to the conditions stated below has been approved for payment to dependants of deceased members of the Australian Imperial Force and the Naval and Military Expeditionary Force who have served abroad. No amount of sustenance allowance is payable unless a member served abroad for a longer period than twelve months.

- 2. "Service abroad" extends from date of embarkation in Australia until date of death.
- 3. The scale is calculated on the following basis :-

Pay.

- (a) 7½ days' pay of rank at time of death for each six months' service abroad.
- (b) Service for a period of less than six months but exceeding four months counts as six months.
- (c) An odd half day in the total amount of the payment period is considered a full day.

Sustenance Allowance.

- (a) Sustenance Allowance at the rate of 3/- per day is payable for the period calculated under (a), (b), and (c) above, provided that the deceased member served abroad for a longer period than twelve months.
- 4. In the case of men who returned to Australia during their period of service or who re-enlisted, only the period of service abroad counts as service for the purpose of this payment.
- 5. Declarations, when completed and addressed, should be forwarded to the District Paymaster of the State in which the soldier enlisted.
