UNIDENTIFIED AUSTRALIAN SOLDIER

Extract from Proceedings of a Court of Enquiry held at Gizeh in connection with the death of an Australian Soldier found near the above-mentioned camp. Vide Defence B.R. 6/951.

5th Witness

No. 141, Pte. Robinson A., 7th Battalion,

A.I.F., acting as C.M.P., states:-

On Friday, January 28th, at 3.45 p.m. I went across to see the body of a soldier which was lying in the scrub some distance from the camp. He resembled Pte. Stores. On the 30th instant I saw Pte. Stores in the camp and so then knew that the body could not be his.

The body I saw was that of a man about 5ft. 8in well built, mid-brown hair, clean shaven and round featured. He had tattoo marks, viz:- a girl's face on one arm and on the other side of the same arm a tombstone with the following inscription "In memory of my friends and dear mother". I did not notice any marks on left arm.

I do not know of anyone resembling the deceased missing from this camp.

The body was tattooed right forearm inside rising sun, clasped hands and tombstone with the following inscription "In memory of my dear mother, all I love" Back of left forearm, woman and crossed flags. No identification disc on the man or any papers about him which would lead to identification. There was a slouch hat lying beside the body with the name "G. Graham" written inside it.

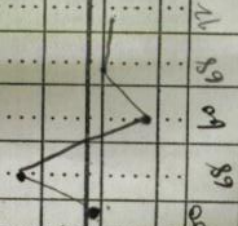
