1. If you fall sick or need medical attention, you should communicate with the nearest Military Hospital.
2. If you need information, communicate with Staff Officer for Invalids and Returned Soldiers, Melbourne.
3. Your Kit will be available at the Kit Store, Domain Camp, 48 hours after disembarkation. If you live in the country and leave instructions, your Kit will be forwarded to the nearest Railway Station. Boat on which you returned should be stated.
4. Kits must be claimed on or before Discharge, or action will be taken to secure their disposal.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SOLDIERS WHO HAVE BEEN MEDICALLY  
BOARDED ON DISEMBARKATION AND RECOMMENDED  
FOR DISCHARGE.

1. On application at Staff Office for Invalids and Returned Soldiers you will be issued with the following :—
    - (a) Free Warrant to your home in Victoria.
    - (b) Clothing to replace unserviceable articles, which latter must be handed in. No issues will be made within 14 days prior to date of Discharge.
  2. As soon as possible Discharge Certificate, Returned Soldier's Badge, and suit of Civilian Clothes will be forwarded to you.
  3. At the expiration of your leave you must be out of uniform.

PARTICULARS REGARDING PAY.

---

1. Payment of Deferred Pay to soldiers who are not admitted to Hospital for treatment, but are recommended for discharge, will be made in full through the Commonwealth Bank to the soldier's credit at his home town, within seven days after disembarkation or arrival in District of Finalization.
2. In isolated cases where a soldier's statement of account does not reach Australia until some time after disembarkation, a substantial advance up to 75% of deferred pay due will be made.
3. Invalids who are admitted to Hospital on disembarkation will receive regular payments each fortnight of the amounts accruing on their Pay Book. On being boarded for discharge, invalids will be paid in advance as under :—

Men enlisted in 1914--15--16	... £10.
.. .. 1917--18	... £5.

The balance of account will be paid to them at their home town, through the Commonwealth Bank, within seven days of the recommendation of the Medical Board for their discharge.
