

OPINION OF THE MEDICAL BOARD

Notes. - (i) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Board, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Commissioners of Chelsea Hospital should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable them to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

- (ii) Expressions such as " may, " " might, " " probably, " &c, should be avoided.
- (iii) The rates of pension vary directly according to whether the disability is sttributed to (a) active service, (b) climate, or (c) ordinary military service, it is therefore essential when assigning the cause of the disability to differentiate between them (see Articles 1162 and 1165, Pay Warrant, 1913)
- (iv) In answering question 20 the Board should be careful to discriminate between disease resulting from military conditions and disease to which the soldier would have been equally liable in civil life.
