Was wounded in France.

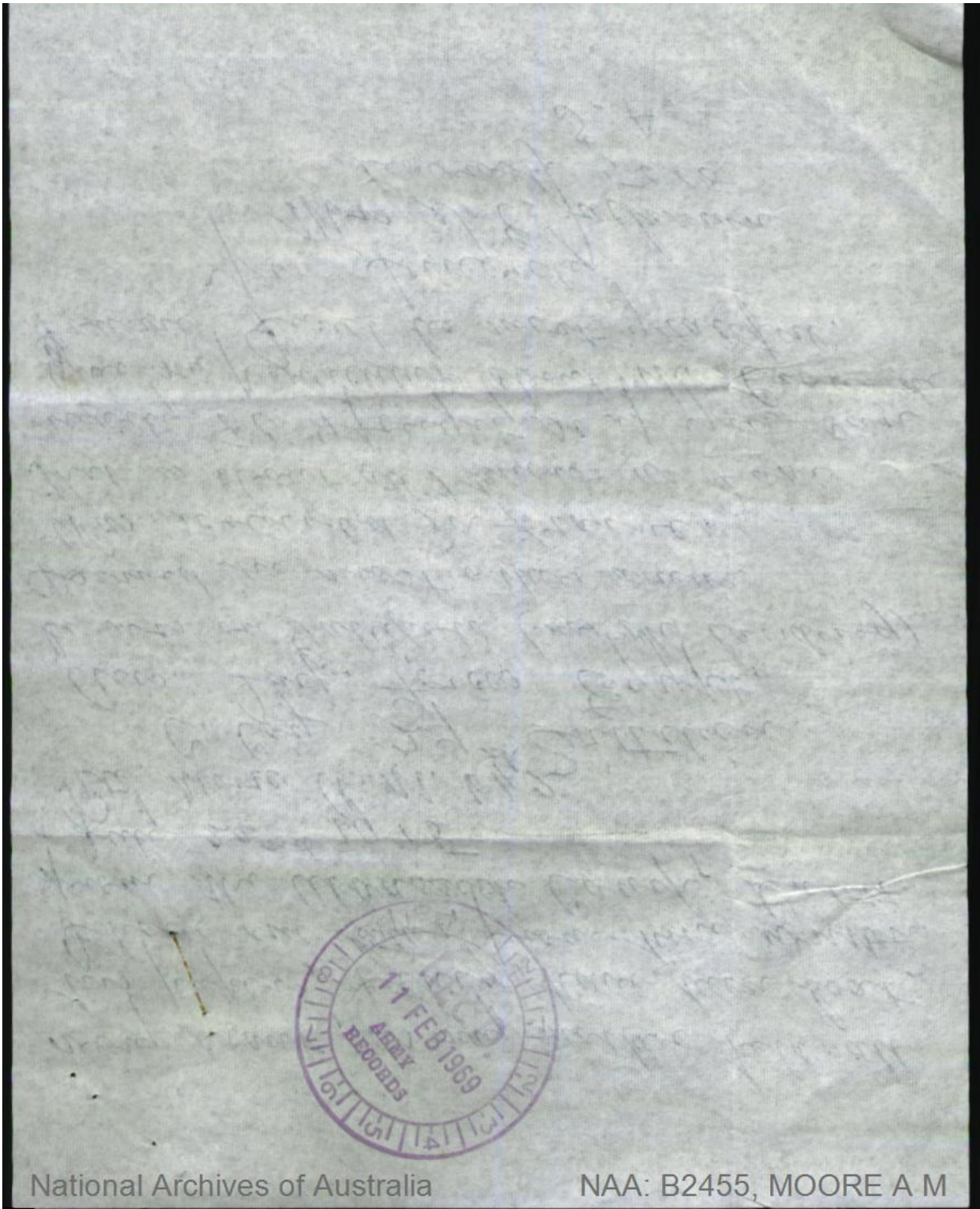
That is about all I know as I am

On 21st September a signal message was received from Headquarters, 7th Australian Infantry Brigade, asking that the abovenamed Officer (then on leave) might be urgently ordered to return to his unit. No record was held of Lieut. Moore's leave or whereabouts, and the Brigade was asked if he had left any address with them. The reply on the 22nd instant was to the effect that his address was Turners Hotel, or c/o Lieut. W. L. Davies, M.C., 27th Bn. Guildford Street, Russell Square. Lieutenant Davies was communicated with by telephone and stated that he was not then aware of Lieut. Moore's location but would make every effort to find him.


Lieut. Moore reported to the D.A.A.G. at these Headquarters on the afternoon of 26th September having received orders left at Turners Hotel from these Headquarters. He was paraded before the A.A.G., Colonel S. Bruggy, D.S.O., and the seriousness of his lapse was pointed out to him. He expressed regret for his breach of regulations in failing to report his leave or give any address here, and his leaving an address with the Brigade at which he could not readily be found.

Divisional Commander may think desirable. It is considered that Lieut. Moore should be considered as absent without leave from 22nd until 26th September inclusive.

He was ordered to proceed overseas to rejoin yesterday, 27th September 1918.
