



## AWARDED THE DISTINGUISHED CONDUCT MEDAL

"With reference to the award of the Distinguished Conduct Medal conferred as announced in the London Gazette, dated 19th November, 1917, the following are the statements of service for which the decoration was conferred:

No. 3263 Sergeant (temporary Company Sergeant Major )

#### H. COLLINS.

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty. He collected a small party and advanced on an enemy block-house, which was garrisoned by about twenty of the enemy with two machine guns. He reached it, well ahead of his men, in spite of heavy machine gun fire, threw some bombs into the block-house, and, entering, forced the enemy out of another entrance into the hands of the men who were following. He set a splendid example of courage and initiative.
