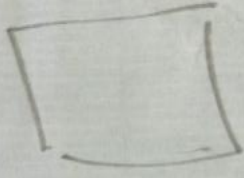





Dear Sir,

Recently I bought a house in which one Hugh J. Boyd, a dentist, had lived for some years at 68 A Bay Rd., Sandringham.

While clearing a lot of rubbish from the cellars I uncovered a W.W.1 steel helmet and a tin with Dr. Boyd's ribbons in it. I noticed that the ribbons included the Military Cross. Although I was friendly with the Doctor, I never knew much about him. I wonder if it is permissible for you to advise me of his war service and the story of his decoration?

Incidentally, the helmet has a lovely round hole in the middle of the forehead section and a groove in the side where a round must have come through and ploughed its way out.

Among the effects I also uncovered a menu for dinner on H.M.T. Transylvania for the evening of 22/6/1916. There were twenty courses. (Did not these old soldiers complain of a plum & apple jam diet?)

There were also numerous military manuals of pre 1914 vintage and notes from the front etc. It is all very interesting to read the treatises on trench warfare and defense of craters etc. at this late stage.
