The Register recording the names and particulars of those members of the British Expeditionary Forces who died in His Majesty's service during the Great War and are buried in the Cemetery shown overleaf has been prepared for publication. It will be the final official record of the War Graves in this Cemetery and copies will be deposited in all the Statutory Libraries of the British Empire for permanent custody.

The Registers contain a full description of the Cemeteries, their history, and directions for reaching them.

If you desire to purchase this Register will you kindly complete and detach the form opposite and forward it WITHIN 10 DAYS with a remittance of three shillings for each copy you require. These copies will then be forwarded to you POST FREE on publication. An acknowledgment of your remittance will be sent within fourteen days of its receipt.


