



Conditions Governing Enlistment, Promotion, Re-muster, Transfer and Discharge.

The following information has been conveyed to the applicant, whose signature is appended:-

- 1. On enlistment, airmen become subject to the Air Force Act and Air Force Regulations as amended from time to time and Orders promulgated under the authority of that Act and Regulations.
- 2. Enlistment will be for the duration of the war and for a period of not more than twelve months thereafter.
- 3. Enlistment is for service anywhere, and no guarantee can be given as to location at any time, but the wishes of personnel will be considered as far as the exigencies of the Service permit. Airmen must be prepared to serve overseas or in Australia.
- 4. Promotion to higher ranks, re-muster to other trades, and transfer to other units are governed by the following factors:—
 - (a) the requirements of the Service;
 - (b) the existence of vacancies;
 - (c) the special qualifications of an airman for holding any position other than that to which he has been appointed.
- 5. Promotion, re-muster, or transfer is always by selection and cannot be claimed as a right by any airman.
- 6. Re-muster to another trade is subject to the applicant having passed the prescribed trade test, and subject to vacancies occurring in approved establishments.
- 7. The passing of an examination for promotion, or a trade test for re-muster, does not entitle the airman to immediate promotion or re-muster, as promotion is always governed by the conditions set out in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 above.
- 8. An airman may be discharged at any time for any of the reasons laid down in Air Force Regulations.
- 9. An airman's fare is paid from his place of residence to his place of enlistment. A married man, who desires to bring his wife and children to his place of enlistment may do so at his own expense.
- 10. If an airman after enlistment desires to change the location of his household, the cost of removal of furniture from his place of residence to his place of enlistment or to any place of subsequent posting must be borne by the airman. No portion of this expense is payable by the Department.
- 11. Airmen receive free medical and prescribed free dental treatment. Their wives and children will not receive free medical or dental attention.
- 12. The rates of pay for airmen enlisted for the period mentioned in paragraph 2 above have been explained to me.

13. I thoroughly understand and accept the conditions set out above.

I submit this report for your information having interviewed Mrs. GRANT, wife of the applicant residing at No.10 Camden Road, NEWTOWN, GEELONG, and also conversation with Dr. BECK of GEELONG. I ascertained the following information:-

Mrs. GRANT stated that she has two children aged 3 years (girl) and 45 years (girl), both of whom are in good health. Continuing, Mrs. GRANT stated that she is suffering from a chronic nerve complaint which is extremely aggravated by her huband's absence and that during the period he was home on leave her health improved greatly as she was relieved of some of the responsibility of her children.

Regarding relatives, Mrs. GRANT stated that her mother and father aged 60 years respectively reside in the neighbouring suburb of CHIIWELL and that also she has one single sister residing with her mother. Continuing, Mrs. GRANT stated that at present she has a married brother and his wife staying with her until such time as he can get a place of his won and also she has one married sister at BARWON HEADS.

Her husband's parents aged 60 years respectively, stated Mrs. GRANT, are residing in GEELONG with their married daughter and one child and that he has no brothers.

Mrs. GRANT stated that her husband aged 29 years has been in the service for 3 years, 12 months of which has been spent in a Northern Area and that it is not the assistance of relatives which she needs but her husband's presence. Finally Mrs. GRANT stated that prior to enlistment her husband worked at the R.S.S.L. Woollen Mills at GEELONG for approximately 9 years and if this application is granted he will return there as the manager, Mr. SCHOLFIELD, stated that he would be only too pleased to make application for him if he is discharged.
