I desire to make application for my discharge from the Royal Australian Air Force, to take effect as soon as possible.

My reasons for applying for this discharge are that I am 39 years of age, and as I understand that the enlistment for airmen in the Permanent Air Force is to be 12 years, I feel that this period is too long for me under the circumstances. I would like to return to civilian life to work in industry and realise that unless I establish myself there before reaching the age of 40 years I will be seriously handicapped endeavouring to do that after that age.

I would also like to state that I would like to be in civilian life owing to the state of my domestic affairs. My wife at present has deserted me, and will not tell me where my two children, aged 15 years and 12 years are. She has not made any attempt at coming to any financial agreement with me regarding our assets which she holds nor will she make any arrangements for me to have access to the children. I have made an allotment ~~to~~ to her from my air force pay in an endeavour to effect a reconciliation with her but without avail.

I have now been informed by my legal adviser that the only action I can take is to take legal action in the Supreme Court for the recovery of my assets from her also for the custody or access to the children. As this process will be fairly costly from a financial point of view I will be in a more favorable position in civilian life to earn more money and make such enquiries to prepare the evidence for this action.

I have no desire to enlist in the Permanent Air Force.

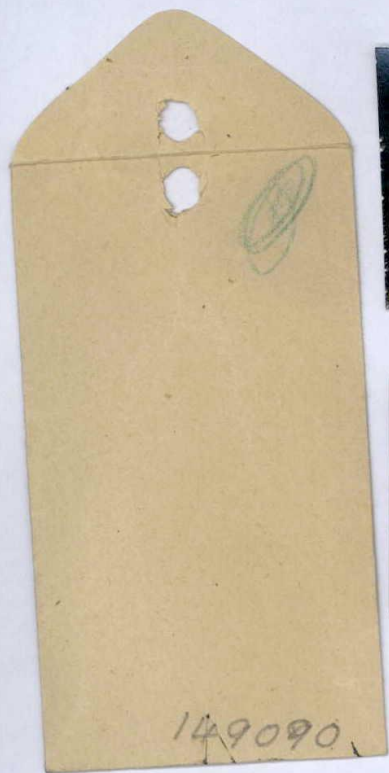

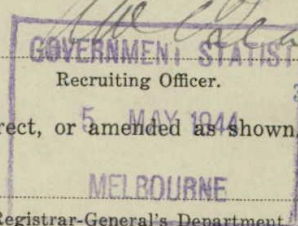

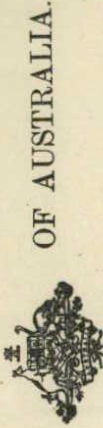
