(iv) normally a will is revoked by marriage and hence a member who marries after making his or her will is required to make a new will. Note, however, that where a member, whose permanent home is in N.S.W., Victoria or Tasmania, has made a valid will which sets out that it is made in contemplation of marriage to a named person and the member matries that person, such matriage will not revoke the will.

If it is desired to alter a will which has been signed a new will must be made and the instructions contained in these Notes followed.

(b) When a member is in actual military service (that is when a state of war exists and the member has taken some step towards joining the field forces)—
