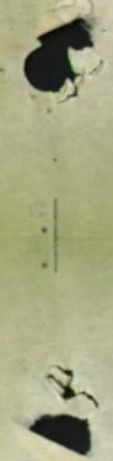


Dear Sir,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your son, the late Major C. R. Seelenmeyer, M.C., 10th Field Artillery Brigade, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that, during the mobile operations near Gailly Cross Roads on 8.8.18, he was in the forward area attending to wounded horses, and whilst performing these duties he was struck in the leg by a flying piece of shell. He was immediately removed to 13th Australian Field Ambulance, where he died of shock some hours later. Chaplain the Rev. Shaw (attached to 10th Brigade) who was present at the time of the casualty, was with him when he died. He was buried in Fouilloy Communal Cemetery, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile South South West of Corbie.

The utmost care and attention is being devoted, where possible, to the graves of our fallen Officers and Men. It is understood photographs are being taken as soon as practicable for transmission to next-of-kin.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.

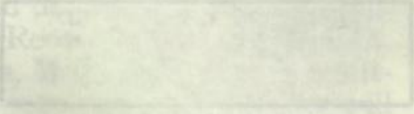

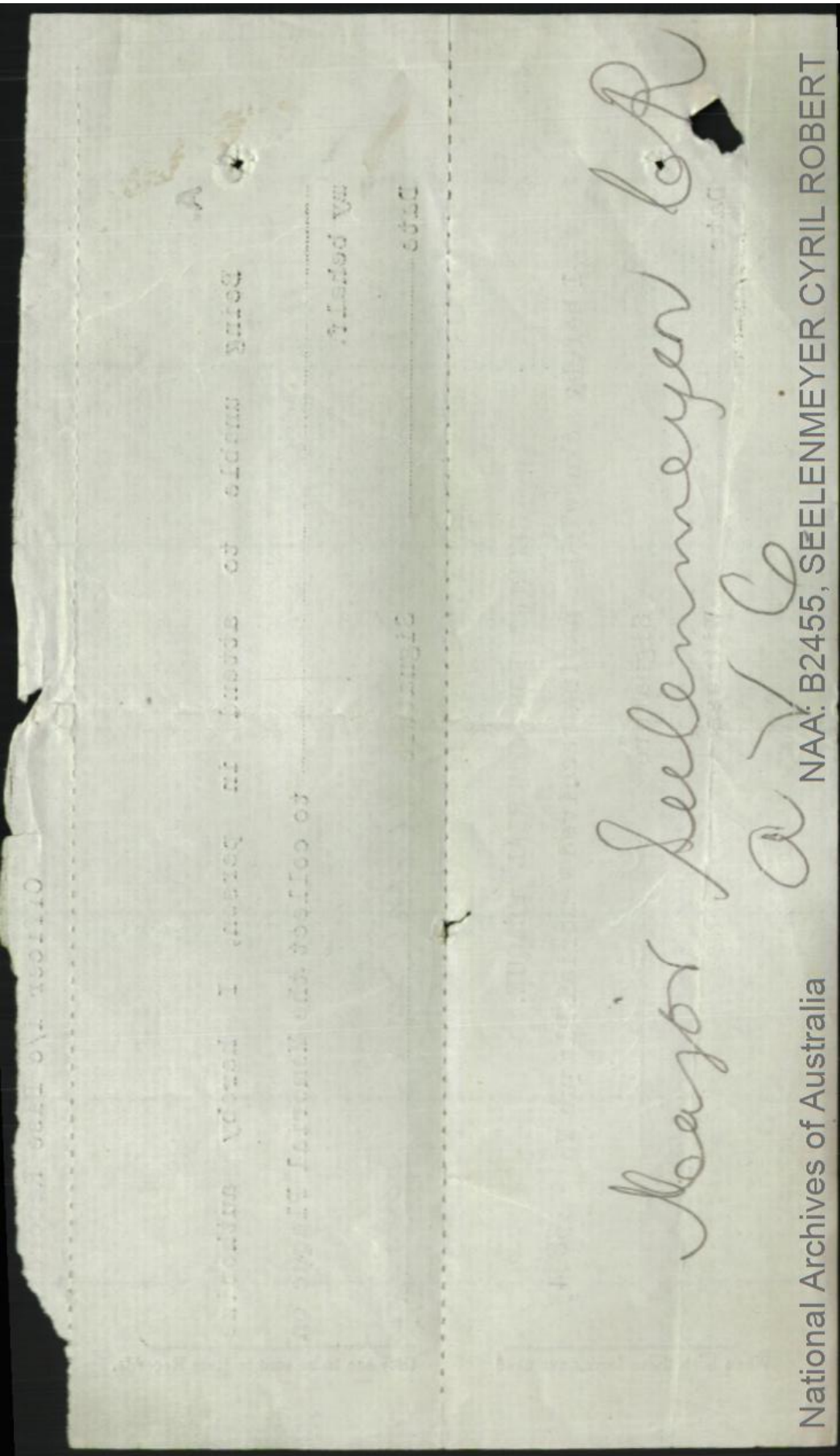
