No. 19632 Bombarrier Charles Harold Lilley, 8th Field Artillery Brigade, Australian Imperial Force, was wounded (gunshot wound multiple) in action on 2nd June, 1917, and admitted to hospital; transferred to Alexandria Hospital, Cotham, on 28th June, 1917; transferred to 1st Auxiliary Hospital on 20th August, 1917; discharged from 1st Auxiliary Hospital on 12th September, 1917, to furlough and to report to Weymouth on 26th September, 1917; returned to Australia (incapacitated) per Hospital Transport "Anchises" which left England on 1st November, 1917, and reached Melbourne on 3rd January, 1918. illness being specified as gunshot wound left thigh, chest and abdomen; discharged as Medically Unfit on 30th March, 1918; The Medical Report dated Harefield, 24th August, 1917, states:-

"The chest wound was penetrating, empyaema developed and resection of 9th left rib was done at No. 11 General Hospital, Staples. He got a lacerated wound on left thigh on outer aspect, 4 inches below crest of ilium, and a wound in left groin. There was a wound of right rectus muscle and an incision 6 inches long was made along its length."
