

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

Transport will fill in all relative particulars shown hereon from information available and hand over, in duplicate, to competent military or other landing authority at port and particulars of soldier's regimental number, rank, name and unit. Date and reason for such disembarkation will, in addition, be shown on weekly Field Return.
- 3. If form is held for a sick man who eventually dies at port, action will be taken by a hospital or other competent authority concerned to cable "Adminaust, London," and "Defence, Melbourne," as follows:—

This form will be forwarded per letter to Officer i/c Records, A.I.F. Headquarters, London, and Officer i/c Base Records, Melbourne, together with full particulars of burial. Funeral charges to be debited to the A.I.F., and account rendered to C.P.M., A.I.F. Headquarters, London, for adjustment.

- 4. The appointed authority is requested to retain these forms while soldier remains at port and wherever possible fill in any subsequent particulars affecting the soldier. The date of admission to and discharge from hospital (in cases of sick personnel) to be clearly shown.
- If soldier is absent without leave, details shown hereon will be passed to A.P.M. or other Police Authority in order to assist in apprehension of soldier.
- 6. When soldier is held to re-embark for destination he should be placed on first available transport. One copy of this form to be handed to O.C. Troops with any additional information recorded thereon and one copy to be posted to Officer i/c Records, A.I.F. Headquarters, Westminster, London.
- 7. On re-embarkation O.C. Transport embarking soldier will fill in particulars at foot of embarkation schedule and also record full details on weekly Army Forms B.213, showing regimental No., rank, name, unit, and date T.O.S. ex......................... The disembarkation form will be filed by Records Clerk and handed to Records Representative on final disembarkation.
